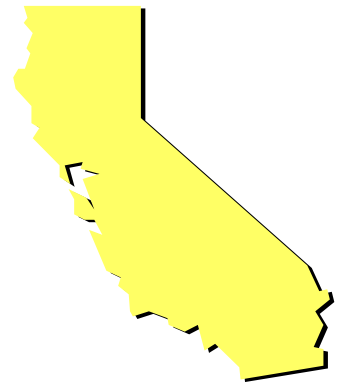

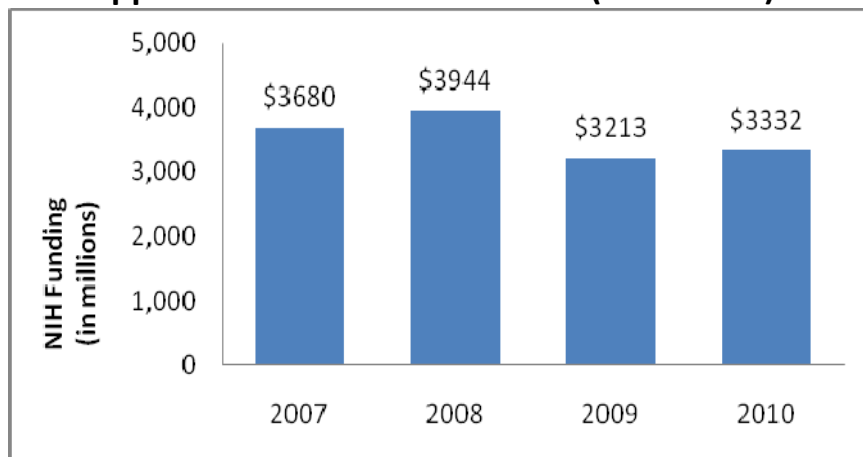

In 2010, the American Cancer Society estimates that

- **569,490** cancer deaths occurred in the U.S., including **55,710** deaths in California.
- **1,529,560** new cancer cases were diagnosed in the U.S., including **152,170** cases in California.

Impact on California Economy

On average, in fiscal year 2007, each dollar of NIH funding generated more than twice as much in state economic output. That is, an overall investment of \$22.8 billion from NIH generated a total of \$50.5 billion in new state business activity in the form of increased output of goods and services.

- Business activity generated per dollar of NIH funding in California was **\$2.40**.
- Total new business activity as a result of NIH funding was **\$8.4 billion**.
- NIH grants and contracts created and supported more than **55,286** jobs that generated wages in excess of **\$3.1 billion** in California. The average wage associated with the jobs created was **\$56,268**.

The Association of American Medical Colleges reports that the member medical schools and teaching hospitals in the state had a combined economic impact of \$35.5 billion (ranked 3rd in the country) and a total employment impact of 200,000 in 2005.
