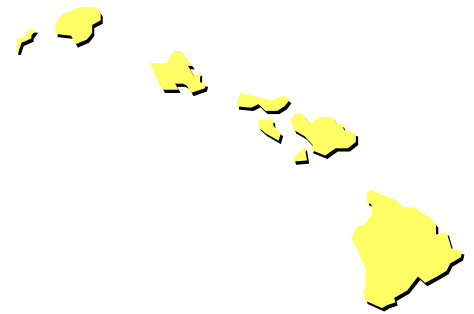

In 2010, the American Cancer Society estimates that

- **569,490** cancer deaths will occur in the U.S., including **2,330** deaths in Hawaii.
- **1,529,560** new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the U.S., including **6,670** cases in Hawaii.

Impact on Hawaii Economy

On average, in fiscal year 2007, each dollar of NIH funding generated more than twice as much in state economic output. That is, an overall investment of \$22.8 billion from NIH generated a total of \$50.5 billion in new state business activity in the form of increased output of goods and services.

In fiscal year 2007:

- Business activity generated per dollar of NIH funding in Hawaii was **\$1.98**.
- Total new business activity as a result of NIH funding was **\$139 million**.
- NIH grants and contracts created and supported more than **1,117** jobs that generated wages in excess of **\$54 million** in Hawaii. The average wage associated with the jobs created was **\$48,248**.
