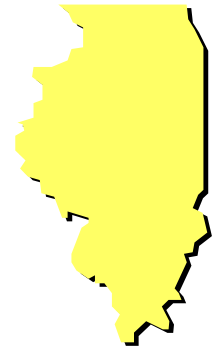

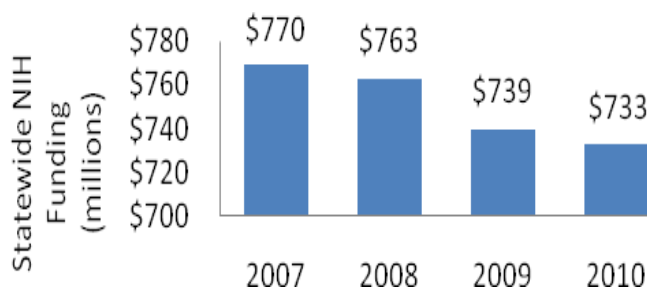

## Impact on Illinois Economy

---

On average, in fiscal year 2007, each dollar of NIH funding generated more than twice as much in state economic output. That is, an overall investment of \$22.846 billion from NIH generated a total of \$50.537 billion in new state business activity in the form of increased output of goods and services.

- Business activity generated per dollar of NIH funding in Illinois was **\$2.43**.
- Total new business activity as a result of NIH funding was **\$1.848 billion**.
- NIH grants and contracts created and supported more than **11,914** jobs that generated wages in excess of **\$662 million** in Illinois. The average wage associated with the jobs created was **\$55,566**.

The Association of American Medical Colleges reports that the member medical schools and teaching hospitals in the state had a combined economic impact of \$23.9 billion (ranked 7<sup>th</sup> in the country) and a total employment impact of 144,200 in 2005.
