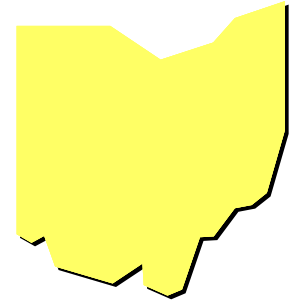

Population: 11,542,645 (2010 Census Estimate)

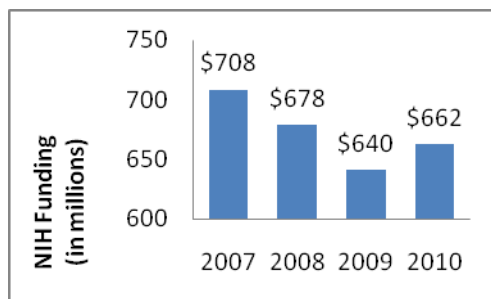

## In 2010, the American Cancer Society estimates that

- **569,490** cancer deaths occurred in the U.S., including **24,980** deaths in Ohio.
- **1,529,560** new cancer cases were diagnosed in the U.S., including **64,450** cases in Ohio.

## Impact on Ohio Economy

---

On average, in fiscal year 2007, each dollar of NIH funding generated more than twice as much in state economic output. That is, an overall investment of \$22.846 billion from NIH generated a total of \$50.537 billion in new state business activity in the form of increased output of goods and services.

- Business activity generated per dollar of NIH funding in Ohio was **\$2.29**.
- Total new business activity as a result of NIH funding was **\$1.627 billion**.
- NIH grants and contracts created and supported more than **11,895** jobs that generated wages in excess of **\$591 million** in Ohio. The average wage associated with the jobs created was **\$49,668**.

The Association of American Medical Colleges reports that the member medical schools and teaching hospitals in the state had a combined economic impact of \$24.5 billion and a total employment impact of 176,400 in 2005.
