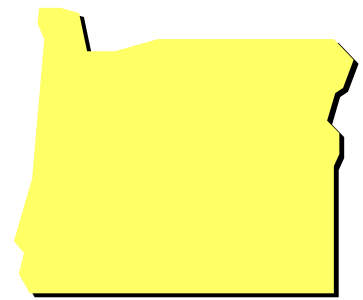


OREGON

Population: 3,421,399 (from Census 2000)



In 2008, the American Cancer Society estimates that

- **565,650** cancer deaths will occur in the United States, including **7,450** deaths in Oregon.
- **1,437,180** new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States, including **19,230** cases in Oregon.
