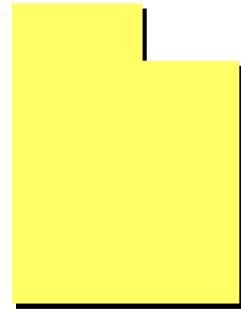

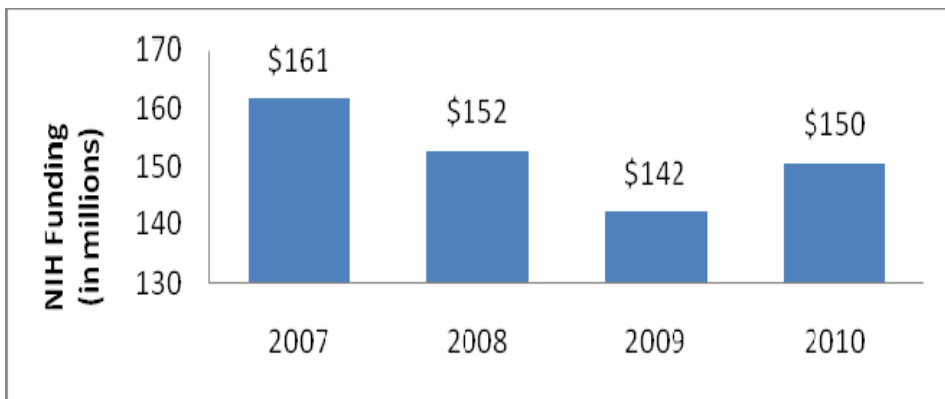
Population: 2,763,885 (from Census 2010)

In 2010, the American Cancer Society estimates that

- **569,490** cancer deaths occurred in the United States, including **2,820** deaths in Utah.
- **1,529,560** new cancer cases were diagnosed in the United States, including **9,970** cases in Utah.

Impact on Utah Economy

On average, in fiscal year 2007, each dollar of NIH funding generated more than twice as much in state economic output. That is, an overall investment of \$22.8 billion from NIH generated a total of \$50.5 billion in new state business activity in the form of increased output of goods and services.

- Business activity generated per dollar of NIH funding in Utah was **\$2.30**.
- Total new business activity as a result of NIH funding was **\$351 million**.
- NIH grants and contracts created and supported more than **3,003** jobs that generated wages in excess of **\$130 million** in Utah. The average wage associated with the jobs created was **\$43,271**.
