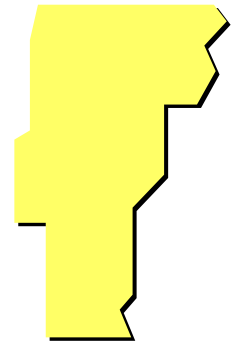


VERMONT

Population: 608,827 (from Census 2000)



In 2008, the American Cancer Society estimates that

- **565,650** cancer deaths will occur in the United States, including **1,140** deaths in Vermont.
- **1,437,180** new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States, including **3,530** cases in Vermont.
