#### Economic Impact of Research<sup>2</sup>

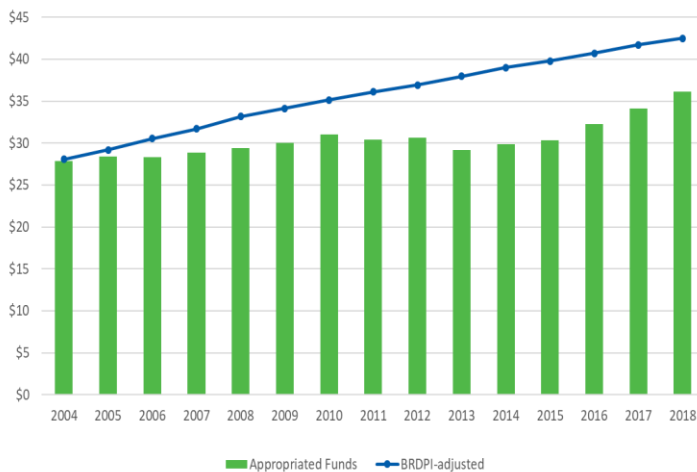
- United for Medical Research reports that in 2017, NIH funded awards totaling **\$3.946 billion** in California, supporting **62,075** jobs and **\$11.031 billion** in economic activity.
- In 2017, the biopharmaceutical industry in California supported **232,910** jobs and **7,902** businesses.

#### Impact of Cancer in California<sup>3</sup>

- In 2018, an estimated 1,735,350 new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, **178,130** will reside in California.
- In 2018, an estimated 609,640 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including **60,650** residents of California.
