Economic Impact of Research²

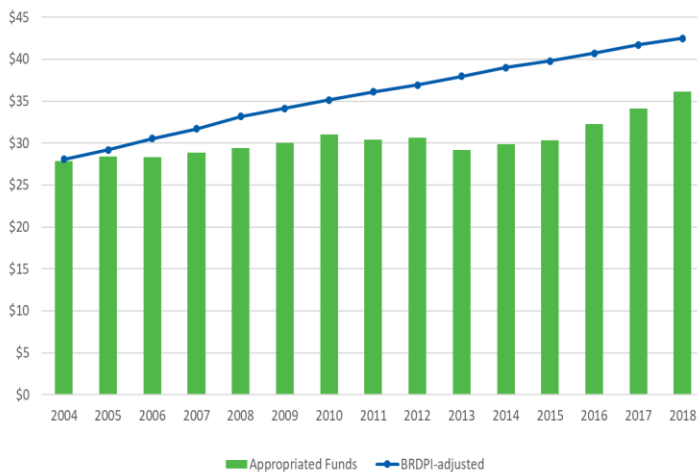
- United for Medical Research reports that in 2017, NIH funded awards totaling **\$649.9 million** in Florida, supporting **14,355 jobs** and **\$2.006 billion** in economic activity.
- In 2017, the biopharmaceutical industry in Florida supported **73,840 jobs** and **5,351 businesses**.

Impact of Cancer in Florida³

- In 2018, an estimated 1,735,350 new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, **135,170** will reside in Florida.
- In 2018, an estimated 609,640 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including **45,030** residents of Florida.
