Economic Impact of Research²

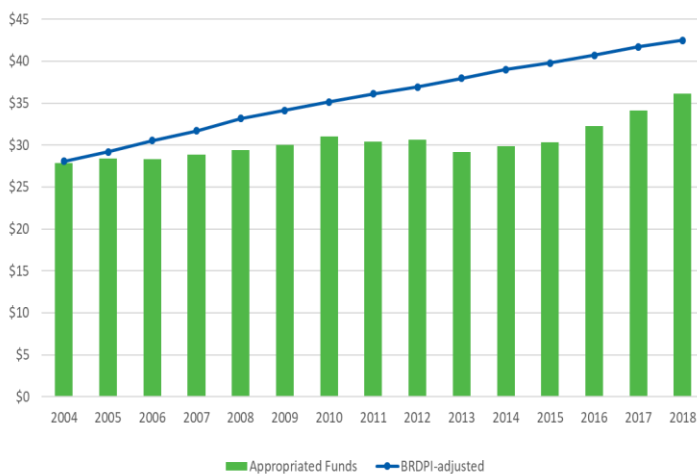
- United for Medical Research reports that in 2017, NIH funded awards totaling **\$537.4 million** in Georgia, supporting **11,199 jobs** and **\$1.591 billion** in economic activity.
- In 2017, the biopharmaceutical industry in Georgia supported **25,797 jobs** and **1,684 businesses**.

Impact of Cancer in Georgia³

- In 2018, an estimated 1,735,350 new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, **56,920** will reside in Georgia.
- In 2018, an estimated 609,640 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including **17,730** residents of Georgia.
