Economic Impact of Research²

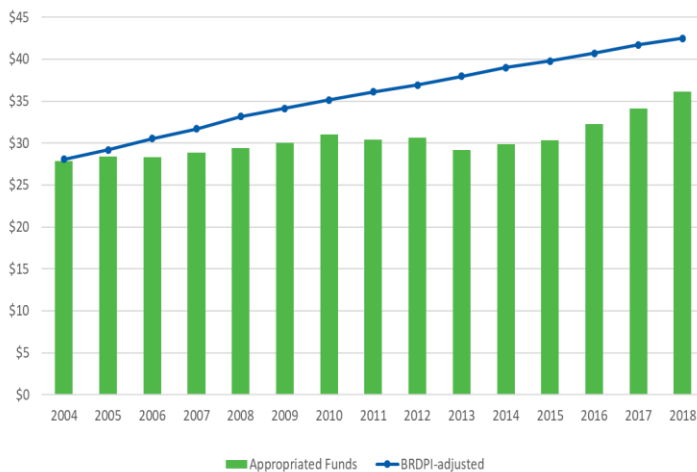
- United for Medical Research reports that in 2017, NIH funded awards totaling **\$49.5 million** in Hawai'i, supporting **1,006 jobs** and **\$147.9 million** in economic activity.
- In 2017, the biopharmaceutical industry in Hawai'i supported **3,485 jobs** and **205 businesses**.

Impact of Cancer in Hawai'i³

- In 2018, an estimated 1,735,350 new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, **6,280** will reside in Hawai'i.
- In 2018, an estimated 609,640 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including **2,580** residents of Hawai'i.
