Economic Impact of Research²

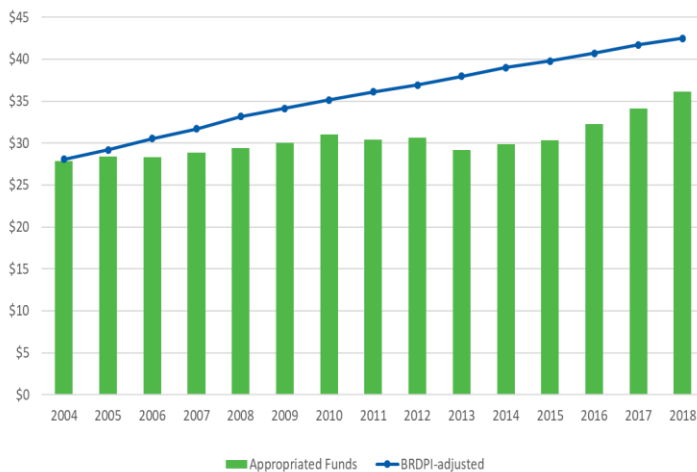
- United for Medical Research reports that in 2017, NIH funded awards totaling **\$260.6 million** in Indiana, supporting **4,716 jobs** and **\$732.4 million** in economic activity.
- In 2017, the biopharmaceutical industry in Indiana supported **52,752 jobs** and **1,862 businesses**.

Impact of Cancer in Indiana³

- In 2018, an estimated 1,735,350 new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, **37,250** will reside in Indiana.
- In 2018, an estimated 609,640 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including **13,820** residents of Indiana.
