### IMPACT

#### Economic Impact of Research<sup>2</sup>

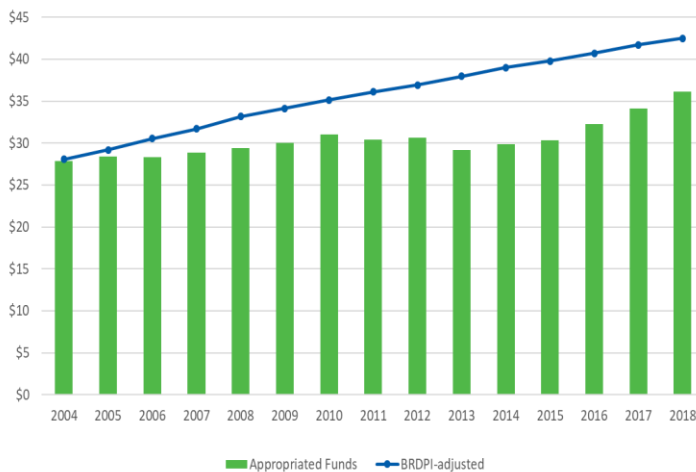
- United for Medical Research reports that in 2017, NIH funded awards totaling **\$100.6 million** in Kansas, supporting **1,734 jobs** and **\$284.6 million** in economic activity.
- In 2017, the biopharmaceutical industry in Kansas supported **12,562 jobs** and **782 businesses**.

#### Impact of Cancer in Kansas<sup>3</sup>

- In 2018, an estimated 1,735,350 new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, **15,400** will reside in Kansas.
- In 2018, an estimated 609,640 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including **5,600** residents of Kansas.
