IMPACT

Economic Impact of Research²


- United for Medical Research reports that in 2017, NIH funded awards totaling **\$141.7 million** in Louisiana, supporting **2,977 jobs** and **\$418.4 million** in economic activity.
- In 2017, the biopharmaceutical industry in Louisiana supported **7,676 jobs** and **930 businesses**.

Impact of Cancer in Louisiana³

- In 2018, an estimated 1,735,350 new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, **25,080** will reside in Louisiana.
- In 2018, an estimated 609,640 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including **9,370** residents of Louisiana.
