Economic Impact of Research²

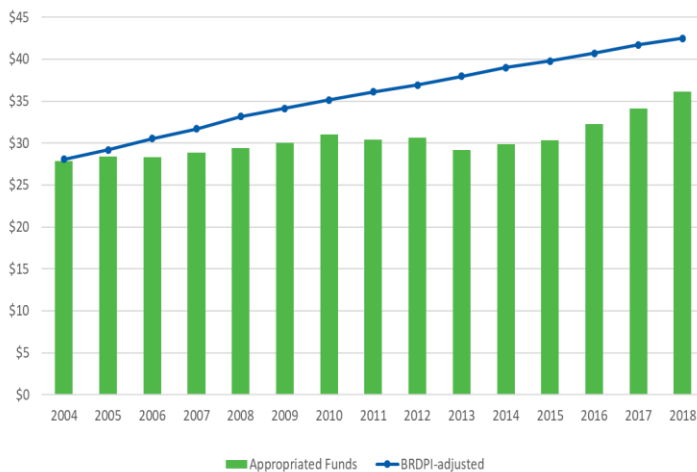
- United for Medical Research reports that in 2017, NIH funded awards totaling **\$1.245 billion** in North Carolina, supporting **20,242** jobs and **\$3.095 billion** in economic activity.
- In 2017, the biopharmaceutical industry in North Carolina supported **62,852** jobs and **2,830** businesses.

Impact of Cancer in North Carolina³

- In 2018, an estimated 1,735,350 new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, **53,130** will reside in North Carolina.
- In 2018, an estimated 609,640 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including **20,380** residents of North Carolina.
