IMPACT

Economic Impact of Research²

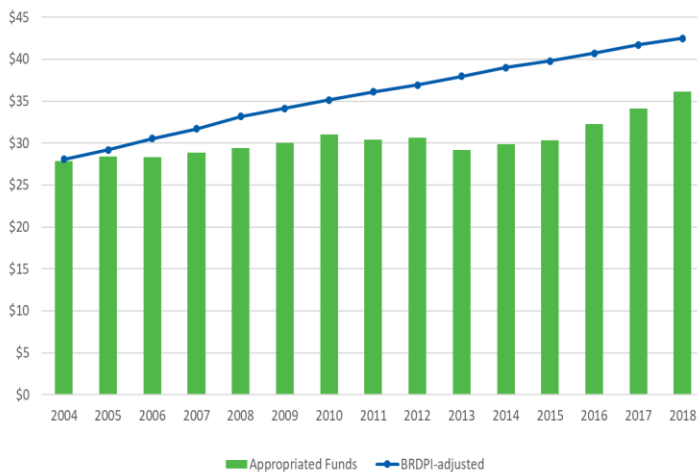
- United for Medical Research reports that in 2017, NIH funded awards totaling **\$92.1 million** in Oklahoma, supporting **2,126 jobs** and **\$292.6 million** in economic activity.
- In 2017, the biopharmaceutical industry in Oklahoma supported **7,642 jobs** and **960 businesses**.

Impact of Cancer in Oklahoma³

- In 2018, an estimated 1,735,350 new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, **19,030** will reside in Oklahoma.
- In 2018, an estimated 609,640 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including **8,470** residents of Oklahoma.
