Economic Impact of Research²

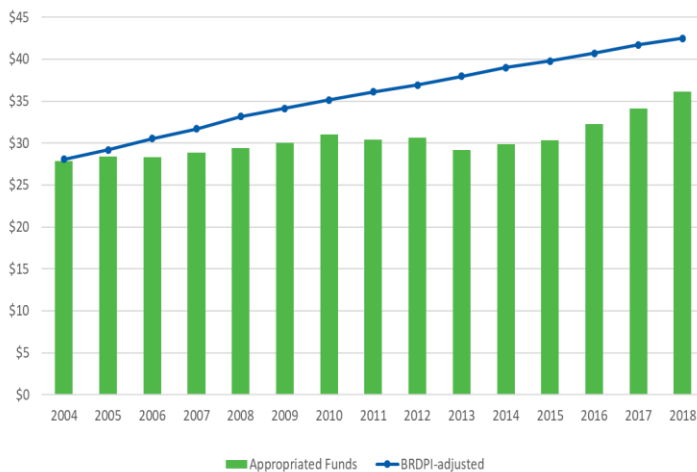
- United for Medical Research reports that in 2017, NIH funded awards totaling **\$183.5 million** in South Carolina, supporting **3,687 jobs** and **\$509.9 million** in economic activity.
- In 2017, the biopharmaceutical industry in South Carolina supported **13,040 jobs** and **1,124 businesses**.

Impact of Cancer in South Carolina³

- In 2018, an estimated 1,735,350 new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, **30,450** will reside in South Carolina.
- In 2018, an estimated 609,640 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including **10,630** residents of South Carolina.
