Economic Impact of Research²

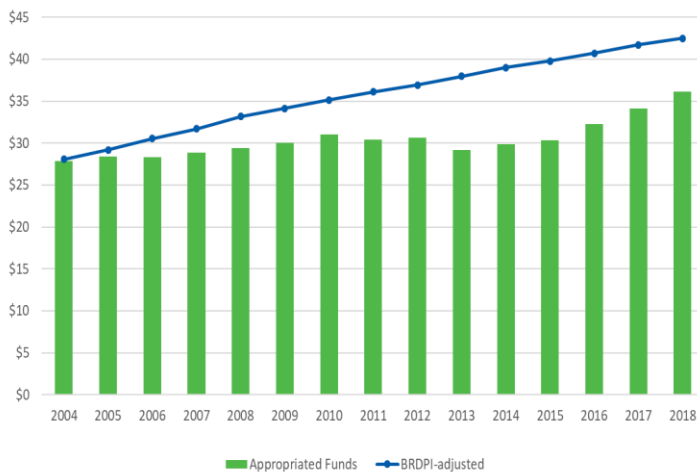
- United for Medical Research reports that in 2017, NIH funded awards totaling **\$1.16 billion** in Texas, supporting **24,341** jobs and **\$3.82 billion** in economic activity.
- In 2017, the biopharmaceutical industry in Texas supported **75,681** jobs and **4,454** businesses.

Impact of Cancer in Texas³

- In 2018, an estimated 1,735,350 new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, **121,860** will reside in Texas.
- In 2018, an estimated 609,640 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including **41,030** residents of Texas.
