IMPACT

Economic Impact of Research²

- United for Medical Research reports that in Fiscal Year 2024, NIH funded awards totaling \$380 million in Alabama, supporting 4,411 jobs and \$916 million in economic activity.
- In FY 2024, the biopharmaceutical industry in Alabama supported 15,776 jobs and 1,737 businesses.

Impact of Cancer in Alabama³

- In 2025, over 2 million new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, 30,030 will reside in Alabama.
- In 2025, an estimated 618,000 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including 10,210 residents of Alabama.

NIH FUNDING

A Strong National Priority⁴



We are advocating for an increase of \$4.5 billion for the NIH in FY 2026.

The Biomedical Research and Development Price Index (BRDPI) measures inflation in the cost of biomedical research. The BRDPI line in the chart above shows the level of NIH funding by year had it kept up with this measure.
