IMPACT

Economic Impact of Research²

- United for Medical Research reports that in Fiscal Year 2024, NIH funded awards totaling \$5.15
 billion in California, supporting 55,324 jobs and \$13.81 billion in economic activity.
- In FY 2024, the biopharmaceutical industry in California supported 347,847 jobs and 15,080 businesses.

Impact of Cancer in California³

- In 2025, over 2 million new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, 199,980 will reside in California.
- In 2025, an estimated 618,000 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including 60,620 residents of California.

NIH FUNDING

A Strong National Priority⁴



We are advocating for an increase of \$4.5 billion for the NIH in FY 2026.

The Biomedical Research and Development Price Index (BRDPI) measures inflation in the cost of biomedical research. The BRDPI line in the chart above shows the level of NIH funding by year had it kept up with this measure.
