### IMPACT

#### Economic Impact of Research<sup>2</sup>


- United for Medical Research reports that in 2017, NIH funded awards totaling **\$523.8 million** in Connecticut, supporting **6,111 jobs** and **\$1.213 billion** in economic activity.
- In 2017, the biopharmaceutical industry in Connecticut supported **23,969 jobs** and **853 businesses**.

#### Impact of Cancer in Connecticut<sup>3</sup>

- In 2018, an estimated 1,735,350 new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, **21,240** will reside in Connecticut.
- In 2018, an estimated 609,640 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including **6,590** residents of Connecticut.
