
### **Economic Impact of Research<sup>2</sup>**

- United for Medical Research reports that in 2017, NIH funded awards totaling \$227.3 million in the District of Columbia, supporting 700 jobs and \$421.2 million in economic activity.
- In 2017, the biopharmaceutical industry in the District of Columbia supported **2,031** jobs and **171** businesses.

## Impact of Cancer in Washington, DC<sup>3</sup>

- In 2018, an estimated 1,735,350 new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, **3,260** will reside in the District of Columbia.
- In 2018, an estimated 609,640 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including **1,030** residents of the District of Columbia.
