IMPACT

Economic Impact of Research²


- United for Medical Research reports that in Fiscal Year 2021, NIH funded awards totaling \$243.5 million in the District of Columbia, supporting 789 jobs and \$474 million in economic activity.
- In FY 2021, the biopharmaceutical industry in the District of Columbia supported 2,720 jobs and 261 businesses.

Impact of Cancer in DC³

- In 2022, an estimated 1,918,030 new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, **3,440** will reside in the District of Columbia.
- In 2022, an estimated 609,360 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including 1,010 residents of the District of Columbia.

NIH FUNDING

A Strong National Priority⁴



Congress has increased the NIH budget by \$14.9 billion—more than 49 percent—over the last seven fiscal years. We are advocating for an increase of \$4.1 billion for the NIH in FY 2023.

The Biomedical Research and Development Price Index (BRDPI) measures inflation in the cost of biomedical research. The BRDPI line in the chart above shows the level of NIH funding by year had it kept up with this measure.
