## Economic Impact of Research<sup>2</sup>


- United for Medical Research reports that in 2019, NIH funded awards totaling **\$630 million** in Georgia, supporting **13,169** jobs and **\$1.871 billion** in economic activity.
- In 2010, the biopharmaceutical industry in Georgia supported **32,040** jobs and **2,431** businesses.

## Impact of Cancer in Georgia<sup>3</sup>

- In 2020, an estimated 1,806,590 new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, **55,190** will reside in Georgia.
- In 2020, an estimated 606,520 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including **17,990** residents of Georgia.
