Economic Impact of Research²


- United for Medical Research reports that in 2017, NIH funded awards totaling \$49.5 million in Hawai'i, supporting 1,006 jobs and \$147.9 million in economic activity.
- In 2017, the biopharmaceutical industry in Hawai'i supported 3,485 jobs and 205 businesses.

Impact of Cancer in Hawai'i³

- In 2018, an estimated 1,735,350 new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, 6,280 will reside in Hawaii.
- In 2018, an estimated 609,640 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including 2,580 residents of Hawai'i.
