Economic Impact of Research²


- United for Medical Research reports that in 2017, NIH funded awards totaling \$805.5 million in Illinois, supporting 14,322 jobs and \$2.463 billion in economic activity.
- In 2017, the biopharmaceutical industry in Illinois supported 70,412 jobs and 3,396 businesses.

Impact of Cancer in Illinois³

- In 2018, an estimated 1,735,350 new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, 66,330 will reside in Illinois.
- In 2018, an estimated 609,640 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including 24,670 residents of Illinois.
