#### **Economic Impact of Research<sup>2</sup>**


- United for Medical Research reports that in 2017, NIH funded awards totaling \$260.6 million in Indiana, supporting 4,716 jobs and \$732.4 million in economic activity.
- In 2017, the biopharmaceutical industry in Indiana supported 52,752 jobs and 1,862 businesses.

#### Impact of Cancer in Indiana<sup>3</sup>

- In 2018, an estimated 1,735,350 new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, 37,250 will reside in Indiana.
- In 2018, an estimated 609,640 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including 13,820 residents of Indiana.
