Economic Impact of Research²


- United for Medical Research reports that in Fiscal Year 2024, NIH funded awards totaling \$141 million in Kansas, supporting 1,752 jobs and \$395 million in economic activity.
- In FY 2024, the biopharmaceutical industry in Kansas supported 20,246 jobs and 1,776 businesses.

Impact of Cancer in Kansas³

- In 2025, over 2 million new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, 15,810 will reside in Kansas.
- In 2025, an estimated 618,000 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including 5,680 residents of Kansas.

NIH FUNDING

A Strong National Priority⁴



We are advocating for an increase of \$4.5 billion for the NIH in FY 2026.

The Biomedical Research and Development Price Index (BRDPI) measures inflation in the cost of biomedical research. The BRDPI line in the chart above shows the level of NIH funding by year had it kept up with this measure.

KU Cancer Center has three interdisciplinary research programs: Cancer Biology; Cancer Prevention & Control; and Drug Discovery, Delivery & Experimental Therapeutics.
