## Economic Impact of Research<sup>2</sup>


- United for Medical Research reports that in Fiscal Year 2024, NIH funded awards totaling \$234 million in Kentucky, supporting 2,815 jobs and \$607 million in economic activity.
- In FY 2024, the biopharmaceutical industry in Kentucky supported **17,341** jobs and **2,407** businesses.

# Impact of Cancer in Kentucky<sup>3</sup>

- In 2025, over 2 million new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, 30,420 will reside in Kentucky.
- In 2025, an estimated 618,000 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including 10,330 residents of Kentucky.

# NIH FUNDING

### A Strong National Priority<sup>4</sup>



We are advocating for an increase of \$4.5 billion for the NIH in FY 2026.

The Biomedical Research and Development Price Index (BRDPI) measures inflation in the cost of biomedical research. The BRDPI line in the chart above shows the level of NIH funding by year had it kept up with this measure.
