Economic Impact of Research²


- United for Medical Research reports that in Fiscal Year 2024, NIH funded awards totaling \$125 million in Maine, supporting 1,468 jobs and \$286 million in economic activity.
- In FY 2024, the biopharmaceutical industry in Maine supported **9,946** jobs and **640** businesses.

Impact of Cancer in Maine³

- In 2025, over 2 million new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, 11,080 will reside in Maine.
- In 2025, an estimated 618,000 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including 3,540 residents of Maine.

NIH FUNDING

A Strong National Priority⁴



We are advocating for an increase of \$4.5 billion for the NIH in FY 2026.

The Biomedical Research and Development Price Index (BRDPI) measures inflation in the cost of biomedical research. The BRDPI line in the chart above shows the level of NIH funding by year had it kept up with this measure.

The JAXCC's members combine unique capabilities to model human cancers in mice with innovations in genomic and computational analytics of human cancers to achieve this mission.
