## **Economic Impact of Research<sup>2</sup>**


- United for Medical Research reports that in 2017, NIH funded awards totaling \$1.611 billion in Maryland, supporting 20,836 jobs and \$3.742 billion in economic activity.
- In 2017, the biopharmaceutical industry in Maryland supported 33,767 jobs and 1,950 businesses.

### Impact of Cancer in Maryland<sup>3</sup>

- In 2018, an estimated 1,735,350 new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, 33,810 will reside in Maryland.
- In 2018, an estimated 609,640 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including 10,780 residents of Maryland.
