Economic Impact of Research²

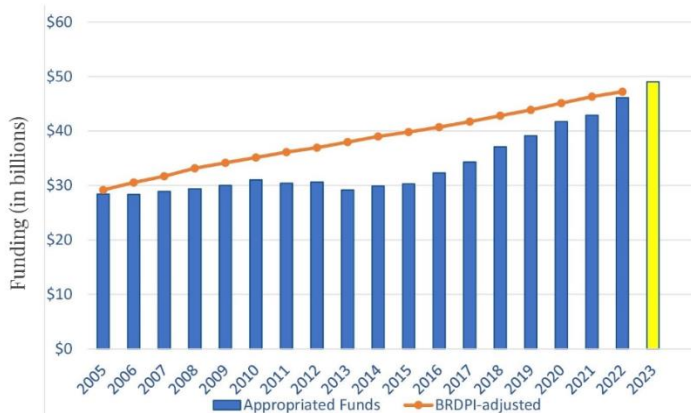
- United for Medical Research reports that in Fiscal Year 2021, NIH funded awards totaling **\$3.328 billion** in Massachusetts, supporting **40,444** jobs and **\$7.837 billion** in economic activity.
- In FY 2021, the biopharmaceutical industry in Massachusetts supported **107,190** jobs and **3,460** businesses.

Impact of Cancer in Massachusetts³

- In 2022, an estimated 1,918,030 new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases **42,190** will reside in Massachusetts.
- In 2022, an estimated 609,360 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including **12,520** residents of Massachusetts.

NIH FUNDING

A Strong National Priority⁴



Congress has increased the NIH budget by \$14.9 billion—more than 49 percent—over the last seven fiscal years. We are advocating for an increase of \$4.1 billion for the NIH in FY 2023.

The Biomedical Research and Development Price Index (BRDPI) measures inflation in the cost of biomedical research. The BRDPI line in the chart above shows the level of NIH funding by year had it kept up with this measure.
