### IMPACT

#### Economic Impact of Research<sup>2</sup>

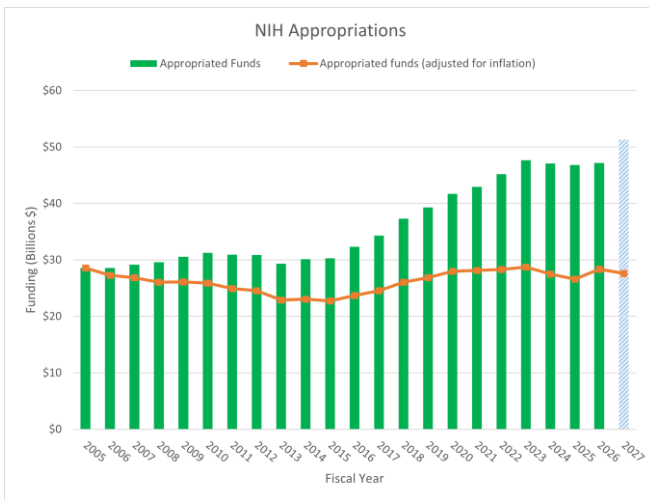
- United for Medical Research reports that in Fiscal Year 2025, NIH funded awards totaling **\$3.41 billion** in Massachusetts, supporting **28,367** jobs and **\$7.64 billion** in economic activity.
- In FY 2025, the biopharmaceutical industry in Massachusetts supported **147,887** jobs and **5,474** businesses.

#### Impact of Cancer in Massachusetts<sup>3</sup>

- In 2026, over 2 million new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, **43,250** will reside in Massachusetts.
- In 2026, an estimated 626,140 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including **12,470** residents of Massachusetts.

### NIH FUNDING

#### A Strong National Priority<sup>4</sup>



We are advocating for an increase of \$4.1 billion for the NIH in FY 2027.

The Biomedical Research and Development Price Index (BRDPI) measures inflation in the cost of biomedical research. The BRDPI line in the chart above shows the level of NIH funding by year had it kept up with this measure.
