
## **Economic Impact of Research<sup>2</sup>**

- United for Medical Research reports that in 2017, NIH funded awards totaling \$707.7 million in Michigan, supporting 11,442 jobs and \$1.835 billion in economic activity.
- In 2017, the biopharmaceutical industry in Michigan supported **40,929** jobs and **1,731** businesses.

## Impact of Cancer in Michigan<sup>3</sup>

- In 2018, an estimated 1,735,350 new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, **56,590** will reside in Michigan.
- In 2018, an estimated 609,640 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including **21,380** residents of Michigan.
