Economic Impact of Research²


- United for Medical Research reports that in 2019, NIH funded awards totaling \$826.5 million in Michigan, supporting 13,365 jobs and \$2.144 billion in economic activity.
- In 2019, the biopharmaceutical industry in Michigan supported **40,206** jobs and **1,772** businesses.

Impact of Cancer in Michigan³

- In 2020, an estimated 1,806,590 new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, 61,770 will reside in Michigan.
- In 2020, an estimated 606,520 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including 21,000 residents of Michigan.
