Economic Impact of Research²


- United for Medical Research reports that in Fiscal Year 2024, NIH funded awards totaling \$1.01
 billion in Michigan, supporting 11,810 jobs and \$2.57 billion in economic activity.
- In FY 2024, the biopharmaceutical industry in Michigan supported 47,815 jobs and 3,319 businesses.

Impact of Cancer in Michigan³

- In 2025, over 2 million new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, 66,040 will reside in Michigan.
- In 2025, an estimated 618,000 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including 21,530 residents of Michigan.

NIH FUNDING

A Strong National Priority⁴



We are advocating for an increase of \$4.5 billion for the NIH in FY 2026.

The Biomedical Research and Development Price Index (BRDPI) measures inflation in the cost of biomedical research. The BRDPI line in the chart above shows the level of NIH funding by year had it kept up with this measure.
