Economic Impact of Research²

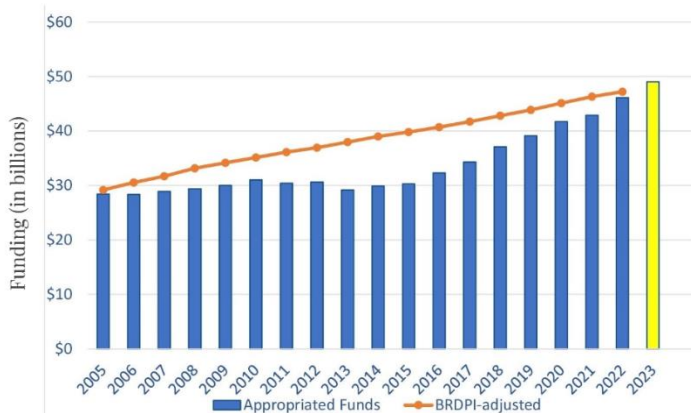
- United for Medical Research reports that in Fiscal Year 2021, NIH funded awards totaling **\$644.5 million** in Minnesota, supporting **9,926 jobs** and **\$1.718 billion** in economic activity.
- In FY 2021, the biopharmaceutical industry in Minnesota supported **59,640 jobs** and **2,310 businesses**.

Impact of Cancer in Minnesota³

- In 2022, an estimated 1,918,030 new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, **35,130** will reside in Minnesota.
- In 2022, an estimated 609,360 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including **10,340** residents of Minnesota.

NIH FUNDING

A Strong National Priority⁴



Congress has increased the NIH budget by \$14.9 billion—more than 49 percent—over the last seven fiscal years. We are advocating for an increase of \$4.1 billion for the NIH in FY 2023.

The Biomedical Research and Development Price Index (BRDPI) measures inflation in the cost of biomedical research. The BRDPI line in the chart above shows the level of NIH funding by year had it kept up with this measure.

MINNESOTA MEMBER CENTERS

The Masonic Cancer Center, University of Minnesota

The **Masonic Cancer Center** has been designated comprehensive and “Outstanding” by the National Cancer Institute (NCI). For more than 25 years, the cancer center’s researchers, educators, and care providers have worked to discover the causes, prevention, detection, and treatment of cancer and cancer-related diseases.

Mayo Clinic Cancer Center

Mayo Clinic Cancer Center was one of the first cancer centers to receive the NCI designation in 1973. Mayo Clinic’s culture of collaboration and teamwork speeds the transformation of laboratory discoveries into lifesaving treatments. Because of this research, more than 120,000 cancer patients come to Mayo Clinic Cancer Center each year seeking medical answers.
