
### **Economic Impact of Research<sup>2</sup>**

- United for Medical Research reports that in 2017, NIH funded awards totaling \$108.9 million in New Hampshire, supporting 1,422 jobs and \$260.7 million in economic activity.
- In 2017, the biopharmaceutical industry in New Hampshire supported **4,936** jobs and **253** businesses.

## Impact of Cancer in New Hampshire<sup>3</sup>

- In 2018, an estimated 1,735,350 new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, 8,080 will reside in New Hampshire.
- In 2018, an estimated 609,640 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including 2,810 residents of New Hampshire.
