IMPACT

Economic Impact of Research²

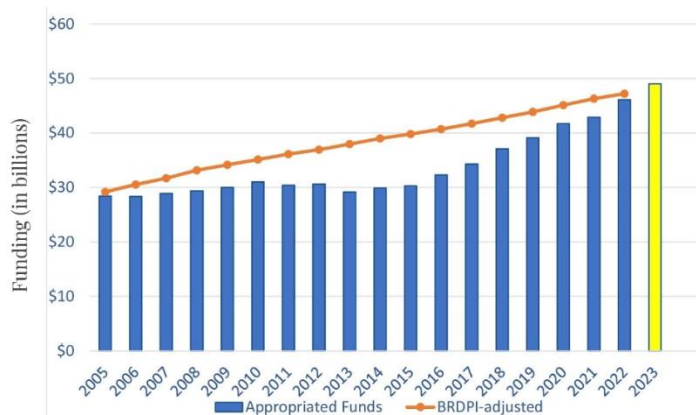
- United for Medical Research reports that in Fiscal Year 2021, NIH funded awards totaling **\$115.5 million** in New Hampshire, supporting **1,585 jobs** and **\$291 million** in economic activity.
- In FY 2021, the biopharmaceutical industry in New Hampshire supported **6,286 jobs** and **413 businesses**.

Impact of Cancer in New Hampshire³

- In 2022, an estimated 1,918,030 new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, **9,430** will reside in New Hampshire.
- In 2022, an estimated 609,360 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including **2,880** residents of New Hampshire.

NIH FUNDING

A Strong National Priority⁴



Congress has increased the NIH budget by \$14.9 billion—more than 49 percent—over the last seven fiscal years. We are advocating for an increase of \$4.1 billion for the NIH in FY 2023.

The Biomedical Research and Development Price Index (BRDPI) measures inflation in the cost of biomedical research. The BRDPI line in the chart above shows the level of NIH funding by year had it kept up with this measure.

Dartmouth Cancer Center

An NCI-Designated Comprehensive Cancer Center, **Dartmouth Cancer Center** encompasses all cancer-related academic activities, patient care, and clinical trials across Dartmouth College and Dartmouth-Hitchcock's health system. NCCC's 123-member, transdisciplinary research infrastructure spans four schools and 24 departments. Its research portfolio includes groundbreaking initiatives in cancer immunology, cancer engineering, population and behavioral sciences, targeted therapy, and more. The center emphasizes translating research discoveries to hard-to-reach populations, especially within its rural catchment area of New Hampshire and Vermont.
