Economic Impact of Research²


- United for Medical Research reports that in Fiscal Year 2024, NIH funded awards totaling **\$132 million** in New Hampshire, supporting **1,191** jobs and **\$323 million** in economic activity.
- In FY 2024, the biopharmaceutical industry in New Hampshire supported 9,330 jobs and 1,048 businesses.

Impact of Cancer in New Hampshire³

- In 2025, over 2 million new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, 10,290 will reside in New Hampshire.
- In 2025, an estimated 618,000 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including 2,980 residents of New Hampshire.

NIH FUNDING

A Strong National Priority⁴



We are advocating for an increase of \$4.5 billion for the NIH in FY 2026.

The Biomedical Research and Development Price Index (BRDPI) measures inflation in the cost of biomedical research. The BRDPI line in the chart above shows the level of NIH funding by year had it kept up with this measure.

Its research portfolio includes groundbreaking initiatives in cancer immunology, cancer engineering, population and behavioral sciences, targeted therapy, and more. The center emphasizes translating research discoveries to hard-toreach populations, especially within its rural catchment area of New Hampshire and Vermont.
