Economic Impact of Research²


- United for Medical Research reports that in 2019, NIH funded awards totaling \$98.1 million in New Mexico, supporting 1,564 jobs and \$244 million in economic activity.
- In 2019, the biopharmaceutical industry in New Mexico supported 7,221 jobs and 640 businesses.

Impact of Cancer in New Mexico³

- In 2020, an estimated 1,806,590 new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, 9,800 will reside in New Mexico.
- In 2020, an estimated 606,520 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including 3,730 residents of New Mexico.

The University of New Mexico Comprehensive Cancer Center is the official cancer center of New Mexico and the only National Cancer Institute-Designated Cancer Center in a 500-mile radius. Its board-certified oncology specialty physicians include cancer surgeons in every specialty, adult and pediatric hematologists/medical oncologists, gynecologic oncologists, and radiation oncologists, who treat patients from every county in New Mexico. Through clinical trials, patients have access to novel cancer prevention strategies and treatments.
