IMPACT

Economic Impact of Research²

- United for Medical Research reports that in Fiscal Year 2024, NIH funded awards totaling \$123 million in New Mexico, supporting 1,351 jobs and \$289 million in economic activity.
- In FY 2024, the biopharmaceutical industry in New Mexico supported 6,666 jobs and 802 businesses.

Impact of Cancer in New Mexico³

- In 2025, over 2 million new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, 11,540 will reside in New Mexico.
- In 2025, an estimated 618,000 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including 3,900 residents of New Mexico.

NIH FUNDING

A Strong National Priority⁴



We are advocating for an increase of \$4.5 billion for the NIH in FY 2026.

The Biomedical Research and Development Price Index (BRDPI) measures inflation in the cost of biomedical research. The BRDPI line in the chart above shows the level of NIH funding by year had it kept up with this measure.

University of New Mexico Comprehensive Cancer Center

The University of New Mexico Comprehensive Cancer Center is the official cancer center of New Mexico and the only National Cancer Institute-Designated Cancer Center in a 500-mile radius. Its board-certified oncology specialty physicians include cancer surgeons in every specialty, adult and pediatric hematologists/medical oncologists, gynecologic oncologists, and radiation oncologists, who treat patients from every county in New Mexico. Through clinical trials, patients have access to novel cancer prevention strategies and treatments.
