
## **Economic Impact of Research<sup>2</sup>**

- United for Medical Research reports that in 2017, NIH funded awards totaling **\$2.386 billion** in New York, supporting **29,679** jobs and **\$5.905 billion** in economic activity.
- In 2017, the biopharmaceutical industry in New York supported **74,557** jobs and **2,918** businesses.

## Impact of Cancer in New York<sup>3</sup>

- In 2018, an estimated 1,735,350 new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, **110,800** will reside in New York.
- In 2018, an estimated 609,640 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including 35,350 residents of New York.
