IMPACT

Economic Impact of Research²

- United for Medical Research reports that in Fiscal Year 2021, NIH funded awards totaling \$3.662
 billion in New York, supporting 44,822 jobs and \$8.919 billion in economic activity.
- In FY 2021, the biopharmaceutical industry in New York supported 88,861 jobs and 4,147 businesses.

Impact of Cancer in New York³

- In 2022, an estimated 1,918,030 new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, 118,830 will reside in New York.
- In 2022, an estimated 609,360 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including 32,230 residents of New York.

NIH FUNDING

A Strong National Priority⁴



Congress has increased the NIH budget by \$14.9 billion—more than 49 percent—over the last seven fiscal years. We are advocating for an increase of \$4.1 billion for the NIH in FY 2023.

The Biomedical Research and Development Price Index (BRDPI) measures inflation in the cost of biomedical research. The BRDPI line in the chart above shows the level of NIH funding by year had it kept up with this measure.
