Economic Impact of Research²


- United for Medical Research reports that in Fiscal Year 2024, NIH funded awards totaling \$3.55
 billion in New York, supporting 30,522 jobs and \$8.27 billion in economic activity.
- In FY 2024, the biopharmaceutical industry in New York supported 117,032 jobs and 5,967 businesses.

Impact of Cancer in New York³

- In 2025, over 2 million new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, 123,430 will reside in New York.
- In 2025, an estimated 618,000 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including 31,190 residents of New York.

NIH FUNDING

A Strong National Priority⁴



We are advocating for an increase of \$4.5 billion for the NIH in FY 2026.

The Biomedical Research and Development Price Index (BRDPI) measures inflation in the cost of biomedical research. The BRDPI line in the chart above shows the level of NIH funding by year had it kept up with this measure.
