# **Economic Impact of Research<sup>2</sup>**


- United for Medical Research reports that in 2019, NIH funded awards totaling \$1.944 billion in Pennsylvania, supporting 26,981 jobs and \$4.930 billion in economic activity.
- In 2019, the biopharmaceutical industry in Pennsylvania supported 81,036 jobs and 2,517 businesses.

### Impact of Cancer in Pennsylvania<sup>3</sup>

- In 2020, an estimated 1,806,590 new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, 80,240 will reside in Pennsylvania.
- In 2020, an estimated 606,520 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including 27,860 residents of Pennsylvania.
