Economic Impact of Research²

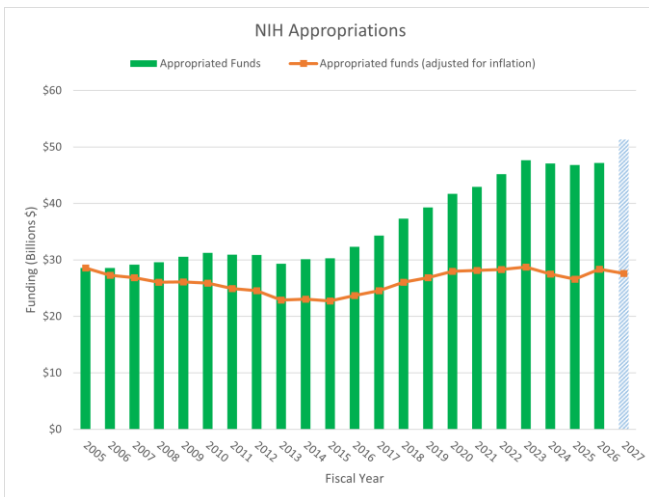
- United for Medical Research reports that in Fiscal Year 2025, NIH funded awards totaling **\$2.27 billion** in Pennsylvania, supporting **21,320** jobs and **\$5.45 billion** in economic activity.
- In FY 2025, the biopharmaceutical industry in Pennsylvania supported **97,374** jobs and **3,710** businesses.

Impact of Cancer in Pennsylvania³

- In 2026, over 2 million new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, **90,250** will reside in Pennsylvania.
- In 2026, an estimated 626,140 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including **27,630** residents of Pennsylvania.

NIH FUNDING

A Strong National Priority⁴



We are advocating for an increase of \$4.1 billion for the NIH in FY 2027.

The Biomedical Research and Development Price Index (BRDPI) measures inflation in the cost of biomedical research. The BRDPI line in the chart above shows the level of NIH funding by year had it kept up with this measure.
