Economic Impact of Research²


- United for Medical Research reports that in 2019, NIH funded awards totaling \$207 million in South Carolina, supporting 4,208 jobs and \$582 million in economic activity.
- In 2019, the biopharmaceutical industry in South Carolina supported 13,967 jobs and 1,520 businesses

Impact of Cancer in South Carolina³

- In 2020, an estimated 1,806,590 new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, 31,710 will reside in South Carolina.
- In 2020, an estimated 606,520 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including 10,780 residents of South Carolina.
