Economic Impact of Research²


- United for Medical Research reports that in Fiscal Year 2024, NIH funded awards totaling \$250 million in South Carolina, supporting 3,650 jobs and \$724 million in economic activity.
- In FY 2024, the biopharmaceutical industry in South Carolina supported 22,093 jobs and 2,519 businesses.

Impact of Cancer in South Carolina³

- In 2025, over 2 million new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, 35,300 will reside in South Carolina.
- In 2025, an estimated 618,000 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including 11,340 residents of South Carolina.

NIH FUNDING

A Strong National Priority⁴



We are advocating for an increase of \$4.5 billion for the NIH in FY 2026.

The Biomedical Research and Development Price Index (BRDPI) measures inflation in the cost of biomedical research. The BRDPI line in the chart above shows the level of NIH funding by year had it kept up with this measure.
