### IMPACT

#### Economic Impact of Research<sup>2</sup>

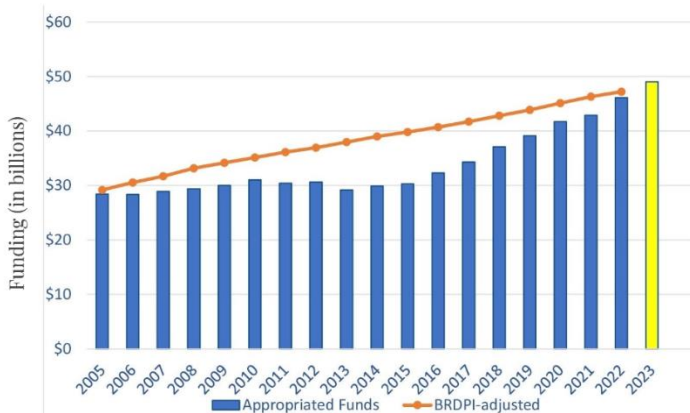
- United for Medical Research reports that in Fiscal Year 2021, NIH funded awards totaling **\$1.64 billion** in Texas, supporting **34,394** jobs and **\$5.4 billion** in economic activity.
- In FY 2021, the biopharmaceutical industry in Texas supported **100,070** jobs and **6,263** businesses.

#### Impact of Cancer in Texas<sup>3</sup>

- In 2022, an estimated 1,918,030 new cancer cases will be diagnosed in the United States. Of these cases, **139,320** will reside in Texas.
- In 2022, an estimated 609,360 Americans will lose their lives to cancer, including **43,490** residents of Texas.

### NIH FUNDING

#### A Strong National Priority<sup>4</sup>



Congress has increased the NIH budget by \$14.9 billion—more than 49 percent—over the last seven fiscal years. We are advocating for an increase of \$4.1 billion for the NIH in FY 2023.

The Biomedical Research and Development Price Index (BRDPI) measures inflation in the cost of biomedical research. The BRDPI line in the chart above shows the level of NIH funding by year had it kept up with this measure.
